23/00948/FUL – Woodpecker Cottage, Coffinswell

Ground mounted solar panels.

Following discussion, the Parish Council unanimously agreed to support the application recognising the need for renewable energy sources. The Parish Council also believes that the panels will not be visible from the public realm and environmental impact will be low.

23/01009/HOU - Ridgeway Cottage, Coffinswell

Two storey and single storey rear extensions.

The Parish Council noted that the proposed extensions are considered as an improvement on the existing assortment of ancillary buildings and would also match the extension recently approved for the neighbouring semi-detached property. The Parish Council unanimously agreed to support the application.
